Additional Notes

- 1. Distance learning note: many ANP courses are distance-accessible to those students who qualify. Please contact your advisor for any questions or concerns.
- 2. NMETH 530, required ONLY for master's in passing students, is a seminar course designed to help you begin working on your thesis, project, or capstone. It is beneficial to have a fairly clear picture the subject of your research interests before taking this course. It is offered twice during the academic year, and should be taken after NMETH 520.
- 3. PHARM II and other elective choices:
 - NSG 521 Infectious Disease and Infection Control (2), taught odd years only
 - NURS 539, Seminar in Critical-Care Nursing (3), taught even years only
 - PHARM 497 Drug Therapy for the Elderly (3), taught all years + in Autumn (nursing focus) and Spring (pharmacist focus)
 - PHARM 515, Pharmacotherapeutics for Acute/Critical Illness (3), taught odd years only
 - PHARM 519, Pharmacotherapeutics for Infectious Disease and Infection (2), taught even years only
- 4. A combined total of 19 credits are required for the NCLIN 549, 550, 551, and 552 series.
