FAQs about the Engaging with Aging Post-doctoral Fellowship based on questions asked by potential applicants:

- Q: Is there an option to start the fellowship in the Fall 2019?
- A: Yes. The Engaging with Aging Fellow can negotiate the start date to be either July 16 or September 16.
- Q: Can the Engaging with Aging project involve study participants with heart disease?
- A: Although the original Engaging with Aging concept has evolved around older adults without chronic conditions, it is possible to structure the EWA project around older adults with a chronic condition.
- Q: Will the position require a RN license?
- A: Having an RN license is one of the preferred criteria. Developing and implementing the EWA project is research focused. One does not need an active Washington State nursing license to apply or be selected.
